Rules and Scoring System

Scoring System

There are 9 points per match as follows:

1 Point for winning a hole X 9 holes = 9Points

(1/2 Point if the hole is tied)

Handicap – 75% of the handicap will be used. Low handicap in the group plays to 0. The rest of the handicaps are adjusted accordingly.

Score Cards shall show **NET SCORES ONLY**

If a team forfeits a match they will receive 0 points and the other team will receive 6 Points.

If both teams forfeit a match each team will receive 0 points.

IMPORTANT - *Please note that when you are posting a score on the Golf Canada website there is a ESC (Equitable Stroke Chart) Button. This will tell you how many strokes you should subtract before posting your score in the system.*

The system allows you to enter 9-hole scores in Match Play even if you do not complete a hole.

Therefore, if there is no activity in your handicap profile (Computer Program) after 2 weeks your team will be docked 1 point per match. After 4 weeks your team will be docked 2 points per match etc. If there is no activity after 10 weeks your team will not be eligible for the playoffs.

The last Men's league game and all Play Off games must be played on or before their scheduled dates.

Play-Offs

Top 24 Teams from each side qualify for the Playoffs

Top 8 Teams from each side receive a buy the first week and participate in a skins game

In case of tie in regular season count back from most point in week 10, 9, 8 etc.

Rules of Competition

2-Man Best Ball Match Play format

In the event of rules clarification please play two balls.

All players must have a valid handicap and must be entering scores.

Slow play is not permitted

Golf Canada Rules to be observed other than modifications from Men's League rule committee on a nightly basis. (Eg. Winter Rules)
